#### **FUND OVERVIEW**

This Fund aims to provide investors with capital growth through investments in stocks with high growth potential over a medium to long-term^ period.

Note: ^"medium to long-term" in this context refers to a period of between 3 to 7 years.

#### The Fund's asset allocation is as follows:

- 90% to 98% of Net Asset Value (NAV): Investments in securities of companies that have good growth potential. In managing these investments, the Fund may invest up to 50% of the NAV in Asia ex-Japan
- 2% to 10% of NAV: Investments in liquid assets including bonds, money market instruments and deposits with financial institutions.

### The Fund is suitable for investors who:

- Wish to participate in the upside of the Asia ex-Japan markets;
- are willing to accept moderate to high risk in their investments; and
- prefer capital growth rather than income over a medium to long-term period.
