FUND OVERVIEW

This Fund aims to provide investment results that closely correspond to the performance of the Kuala Lumpur Composite Index (KLCI) or such other index as may be replaced by Bursa Malaysia Securities

Note: Effective 6 July 2009, Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad replaced the KLCI with the FBM KLCI.

The Fund's asset allocation is as follows:

- 90% to 99.5% of Net Asset Value (NAV): Investments in the FBM KLCI component stocks;
- 0% to 10% of NAV: Participation in financial derivatives;
- 0.5% to 10% of NAV: Investments in liquid assets including money market instruments and deposits with financial institutions.

The Fund is suitable for investors who:

- Sseek equity market returns as measured by the benchmark FBM KLCI;
- prefer passive investment management; and
- are willing to accept high risk in their investments in order to obtain capital growth over a short to medium term period.


